PROCEEDINGS COMMENCED BY NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL BUILDING SOCIETY, HALIFAX BUILDING SOCIETY, ALLIANCE & LEICESTER BUILDING SOCIETY AND WOOLWICH BUILDING SOCIETY

1. With immediate effect, in any proceedings before the Court, Abbey National plc shall be substituted for National and Provincial Building Society, Halifax plc shall be substituted for Halifax Building Society, Alliance & Leicester plc shall be substituted for Alliance & Leicester Building Society and Woolwich plc shall be substituted for Woolwich Building Society.
2. Orders in which National and Provincial Building Society, Halifax Building Society, Alliance & Leicester Building Society or Woolwich Building Society is named as plaintiff may be enforced by Abbey National plc, Halifax plc, Alliance & Leicester plc or Woolwich plc (as the case may be) without an application for leave to enforce being necessary by reason only of the conversion from building society to public limited company and Rule 5(1)(b) of the Judgment Enforcement Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981.
