

PRACTICE DIRECTION NO 6 of 2012

**IN THE COURT OF JUDICATURE OF NORTHERN IRELAND
AND
COUNTY COURT**

VIRGIN MONEY PLC (formerly trading as NORTHERN ROCK PLC)

1. On 12th October 2012, Northern Rock Plc changed its name and is now incorporated as a public limited company under the name Virgin Money Plc.
2. On and with effect from 12th October 2012, in respect of any proceedings to be continued by Northern Rock Plc in any Court in Northern Ireland in which Northern Rock Plc is a party, Virgin Money Plc shall be substituted as a party therefor.
3. Any party to such proceedings may apply to the court in which the proceedings are to be dealt with for an order that the substitution of name shall not have effect in those proceedings.
4. Any judgment or order of any court in Northern Ireland in which Northern Rock Plc is named as a party may be enforced by or against Virgin Money Plc without the leave of the court, whether under paragraph 1 and Rule 5(1)(b) of the Judgement Enforcement Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981 or otherwise.
